Collecting feedback from stakeholders is very important for the success of each organization. The college seeks feedback from all stakeholders, including students, alumni, teachers, and parents, based on the curriculum. All these responses were analyzed and action was taken.

Student Feedback:

The following facts are emerged from the feedback received from the students about the current curriculum and syllabus taught in the college.

1. Most of the students are satisfied with the course which is easy to understand and the teachers complete the syllabus within time.
2. Students are satisfied with extra curriculum activities such as field visit, project, Quiz, assignments, and presentation.
3. According to most of the students, teachers have good subject knowledge and they are punctual in the class.
4. Students are satisfied with course content which is easily available in the library and the syllabus is job oriented.
5. According to students, teachers used various teaching aids like projector, reference books, handouts, seminar, tutorials, group discussion etc.

Alumni Feedback:

Alumni Analysis of Alumni Feedback for this year reveals the following.

1. Most of the alumni feel proud being students of this institution.
2. Alumni are satisfied with various kinds of activities which are held for over all development of the student. They are willing to contribute for the development of the institute.
3. According to alumni the campus environment is conducive for the development of student and the college provides enough amenities.
4. Alumni are satisfied with teaching standard assessment and examination system. They liked the course content which is useful for the employment.

Parent Feedback:
